

RULES FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

The following rules apply to any individual who wishes to speak before the Franklin County Board of Commissioners during briefing meetings:

1. This form must be filled out completely and submitted to the front desk receptionist 15 minutes prior to the start of briefing. The form will be time stamped upon receipt and late or incomplete forms will not be accepted.
2. Three (3) speakers will be permitted to speak per briefing and will be invited to speak in the order public comment request forms are submitted.
3. Speaker remarks may not contain obscenity, commercial advertising, defamation or slander, nor will speakers conduct themselves in violation of the "Disorderly Conduct" or the "Disturbing a Public Meeting" provision of the Ohio Revised Code. All comments will be directed to the Board of Commissioners. Permission to speak may be denied or terminated if remarks are disrespectful or antagonistic. Briefing is not an adversarial proceeding.
4. Individuals may address the board a maximum of one time per month.

The receptionist will present speaker slips to the President of the Board in the order received.
