Mound Street Community Garden

Franklin County is pleased to announce the opening of the Mound Street Community Garden, downtown Columbus’ only community garden. Located at 50 East Mound Street, at the corner of East Mound Street and Pearl Alley, the garden is available to anyone with a passion to grow food. Persons may request individual plots to grow vegetables personally or volunteer to help grow foods in beds dedicated to support local food pantries and shelters.

Applications for individual plots will be accepted through Friday, April 5. Opening Day is Saturday, April 20.

All beds are 4’x8’ raised beds. Each bed is divided into two 4’x4’ plots. Beds 1-11 are 16” high; beds 12-19 are 30” high. Gardeners may request up to 4 plots.

All participating gardeners will receive: A garden plot(s) for use during daylight hours of the growing season and water. Gardeners must supply their own seeds, plants, tools and watering hose.
