**Franklin County Offices Closed in Honor of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day,
Commissioners General Session Cancelled for Tuesday**

As a reminder, Franklin County offices are closed on Monday, January 21st, in honor of the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday, recognizing the life and legacy of the historic civil rights icon.

County Commissioners invite residents to attend the annual community celebration at Veterans Memorial on Monday at 6:00pm. This year's theme is "Celebrate the Legacy: Guided by Faith." This free family-focused program will focus on the men and women who were contemporaries of Dr. King and helped to change our world through the civil rights movement. The celebration will feature musical performances by the Jazz Arts Academy and the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Mass Children's Choir and dances performed by Ballet Met.
