ENGINEER

William "Fritz" Crosier, Chief Deputy of Engineering, Engineer's Office, offered a resolution authorizing a one-year contract with Epoch Cleaning LLC, dba Stratus Building Solutions of Columbus to assist with cleaning at the Franklin County Engineer's facilities (\$19,620.00) (Engineer).

JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES

Bart Logan, Deputy Director, Communications, Job and Family Services, offered a resolution, tabled on October 4, 2022, approving subaward agreements with multiple community agencies for Franklin County Out-of-School Time youth programming (\$7,735,113.30) (Job and Family Services).

Joy Bivens, Deputy County Administrator: On Tuesday, this Board tabled this resolution. There was a question regarding Always Together Charities. George Reese is a part of that organization, and he will be here on Tuesday to answer questions. On October 17, 2022, I will be meeting with all of the youth providers that provide youth sports programming within Franklin County Legacy U. They work with approximately 4,000 families, and the purpose of the meeting is to discuss how they successfully contract with Franklin County, knowing that a lot of their organizations are not sophisticated enough to take government funding. Ten to fifteen youth providers are expected to attend this meeting, and I am also requesting that our purchasing representative is in attendance, as well as our other Human Services agencies that will be contracting with these organizations.

Bart Logan offered a resolution approving a subaward agreement with the Educational Service Center of Central Ohio for the Partnership for Success youth practitioner training services (\$305,000.00) (Job and Family Services).
