FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

Briefing Session Minutes Thursday, November 30, 2023

The purpose of the meeting was to review resolutions submitted for the December 5, 2023, General Session, and to discuss other matters pertaining to the programs of the agencies.

Commissioner Boyce convened the meeting at 9:30 A.M.

CORONER

Patrick McLean, Chief of Staff, Coroner's Office, offered a resolution authoring an agreement with FlowPartner LLC, a communications and personnel consulting firm, for internal communications and team building services for the Franklin County Forensic Science Center, Office of the Coroner (\$20,000.00) (Coroner).

Mr. McLean reviewed information found in documents submitted with the proposed resolution.

Commissioner Boyce noted that a staffing study had been conducted to evaluate a more strategic, need-based approach to staffing the Coroner's Office. He asked if that study had been completed. Kenneth N. Wilson, County Administrator, stated that the study was completed and the results were received. He explained that it resulted in adding positions that are part of the 2024 recommended budget. Kris J. Long, Deputy County Administrator, added that the Board of Commissioners adopted a resolution a couple of weeks back to approve an agreement with Moody Nolan to come into the Coroner's space and do some tweaks based on the results of the operations study to ensure that the space is working for the Coroner's Office staff going forward. Commissioner Boyce stated that this is critical, and he is glad to hear how it is moving forward.

ENGINEER

Nick Soulas, Government Affairs Liaison, Engineer's Office, offered a resolution for plans approved for the improvement of Chambers Road, from Kenny Road to Hess Boulevard, Clinton Township, and for the improvement of all streets within the Westbrook Subdivision, Franklin Township, Franklin County, Ohio (Engineer).

Mr. Soulas reviewed information found in documents submitted with the proposed resolution.

Nick Soulas offered a resolution approving a contract modification with J & J Schlaegel, Inc. for the Elliott Road and Hayden Run Road Drainage Improvement Project, an increase of \$234,150.30, for a revised contract amount of \$3,180,675.18 (\$234,150.30) (Engineer).

Mr. Soulas reviewed information found in documents submitted with the proposed resolution.

Nick Soulas offered a resolution approving a contract modification with Decker Construction Company for the Improvements of Fisher Road, an increase of \$125,202.52, for a revised contract amount of \$1,521,135.27 (\$125,202.52) (Engineer).

Mr. Soulas reviewed information found in documents submitted with the proposed resolution.

Nick Soulas offered a resolution approving a contract modification with Double Z Construction Company for the 2023 General Bridge Maintenance project, an increase of \$215,000.00, for a revised contract amount of \$789,481.80 (\$215,000.00) (Engineer).

Mr. Soulas reviewed information found in documents submitted with the proposed resolution.

Nick Soulas offered a resolution granting approval to declare equipment obsolete and no longer needed for Franklin County use, and authorizing sale of said equipment (Engineer).

Nick Soulas offered a resolution requesting the Ohio Department of Transportation to reduce the speed limit on Rohr Road, County Road No. 235, Hamilton Township, City of Obetz, Franklin County, Ohio (Engineer).

Nick Soulas offered a resolution for report (2nd) of the Franklin County Engineer, establishing sums of compensation for a portion of the owners of property abutting the Cleveland Avenue from

Huy Road to Cooke Road Improvement project, Clinton Township, Franklin County, Ohio (\$2,834.00) (Engineer).

Mr. Soulas reviewed information found in documents submitted with the proposed resolution.

SHERIFF

Albert J. Smith III, Assistant Finance Director, Sheriff's Office, offered a resolution authorizing a consultant contract with The Ohio State University for crime research services (\$50,000.00) (Sheriff).

Mr. Smith reviewed information found in documents submitted with the proposed resolution.

PUBLIC DEFENDER

Christine Clarizio, Controller, Public Defender's Office, offered a resolution authorizing an agreement with Ralph Andersen & Associates for recruitment services for the position of Public Defender (\$49,750.00) (Public Defender).

Ms. Clarizio reviewed information found in documents submitted with the proposed resolution.

Commissioner Boyce asked about the timeline of this agreement and, specifically, if the recruitment would conclude before the retirement of the current Public Defender. Ms. Clarizio stated that Ralph Andersen & Associates should not have any issues completing this work by March 2024. Jeanine Hummer, First Assistant Prosecuting Attorney and Chief Counsel, Prosecuting Attorney's Office, added that this agreement is already negotiated, so as soon as it is signed, it is ready for launch.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY

Jeffrey J. Young, Director, Emergency Management Agency, offered a resolution authorizing the Franklin County Administrator and the Director of Franklin County Emergency Management and Homeland Security to execute an FY2023 State Homeland Security Program grant and authorizing the Director of Franklin County Emergency Management and Homeland Security to be the designated Agent for administration purposes (\$333,300.00) (Emergency Management Agency).

Mr. Young reviewed information found in documents submitted with the proposed resolution.

JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES

Bart Logan, Deputy Director, Communications, Job and Family Services, offered a resolution approving a sub-award agreement with the Columbus Urban League for the Journey to Wealth program (\$150,000.00) (Job and Family Services).

Mr. Logan reviewed information found in documents submitted with the proposed resolution.

PURCHASING

Megan Perry-Balonier, Director, Purchasing, offered a resolution approving one purchase order for the Franklin County Treasurer's Office for Huntington National Bank (\$5,000.00) (Purchasing).

Ms. Perry-Balonier reviewed information found in documents submitted with the proposed resolution.

Megan Perry-Balonier and Tameca Bumper, Economic Equity Administrator, Office of Diversity Equity and Inclusion, offered a resolution approving purchases for various Franklin County agencies (\$4,090,025.98) (Purchasing).

Mr. Talarek reviewed information found in documents submitted with the proposed resolution.

Kris J. Long, Deputy County Administrator, Board of Commissioners, offered a resolution of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners to convene into Executive Session for the purpose of considering personnel matters and to confer with the Franklin County Prosecutor's Office concerning pending or imminent litigation (Board of Commissioners).

Ms. Long noted that this proposed resolution is to be considered by the Board of Commissioners during General Session on Tuesday, December 5, 2023.

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The Clerk noted that there will be four (4) journalizations expected at General Session on Tuesday, December 5, 2023.
