MINUTES OF GENERAL SESSION

January 18, 2022

The Franklin County Board of Commissioners convened in the Commissioners Hearing Room, at 9:00 A.M. on Thursday, January 18, 2022.

Commissioner Crawley called the meeting to order at 9:19 A.M.

Approval of the minutes of the January 3, 2022, Organizational Meeting; and, the January 3, and January 6, 2022, General Sessions. Commissioner Boyce moved to approve the minutes, seconded by Commissioner O'Grady. The minutes were unanimously approved by roll call vote.
