The Franklin County Board of Commissioners convened an Administrative Briefing, via conference call, to ensure timely and accurate collaboration, coordination, and situational assessments amongst county partners, in addressing the COVID-19 pandemic.

President O'Grady convened the meeting at 9:01 A.M.

Updates from Franklin County Public Health, county administration, issues pertaining to resident and county employee needs, federal and state legislative updates, community updates, and determining next steps were addressed, during the conference call.

14,230 confirmed cases of COVID-19 were noted within Franklin County Public Health's jurisdiction; 351,419 cases were reported in Ohio; and, 5,996 deaths were attributed to COVID-19 in the state.

With no further business before the Board, the meeting was adjourned at 9:32 A.M.




